Talked about Houston and Island Ave. Abbey Beck wants to do a pedestrian/biking friendly business plan. She is working on a grant to fund a test for a bike/pedestrian space on the road on Island.

Bikes For Batavia: We gave 1 bike to the pantry, but with input from the city, we decided the pantry can not give the bikes away. Clients can get a bike by messaging Bicycle Commission or CHIP IN. We sent Betsy a waiver and a client did sign it and took the one bike we gave them.

SRTS Grant: The city submitted a grant for sidewalks, so the BBC can not submit another one this year.

Critical mass ride: Planning ride for last Friday of the month in October

Bike Education: Joanne will talk to Ed Barsotti about what State will require with the new to teach bike education to elementary students.

The Bike Walk Education in Schools Act clarifies the existing traffic safety K-8 school curriculum requirement to specifically include biking and walking safety. Illinois crash data shows nearly five children are hit by drivers every day while walking or biking within one block of a school.
