Deerpath Road over Mill Creek improvement consists of bridge widening and superstructure replacement. The purpose of widening the bridge is to provide a sidewalk on the left side and a bike path on the right side of the bridge. The proposed sidewalk and bike path will extend along the length of Deerpath Road between Saupp Drive (formerly Limestone Drive) and Main Street. In addition, there will be new curb and gutter added along the roadway with pavement resurfacing, new drainage system, watermain relocation, Batavia electric relocation, compensatory storage, wetland mitigation, guardrail, pavement markings and signing, erosion and sediment control, and landscaping.
