RE: Prairie Street Reconstruction Project (Wilson Street to Pine Street)

Dear Resident,

The City of Batavia has recently been informed by IDOT that the Prairie Street Reconstruction will be starting in the next 1-2 weeks. We are very pleased that the project will be getting underway but unfortunately will not be able to provide a Public Informational meeting due to the COVID-19 stay-at-home order currently in place as all City Buildings have been closed to the public.

To give you a brief update on the status we've spoken to the contractor, Pirtano Construction, and their plan is to start with preliminary set-up work on April 27th. This initial work will include the installation of traffic control signage, erosion control, tree protection fencing, and construction layout staking. There will also be utilities that need to be relocated prior to the actual work starting, so expect to see some excavation work in the area by NICOR, AT&T, or Comcast.

City staff will be attending a virtual preconstruction meeting with IDOT on Wednesday April 22, 2020. At that time, we will get a full detailed schedule from the contractor on the upcoming work. Once the work is underway we will also post weekly updates on the project webpage at <https://www.cityofbatavia.net/794/Prairie-Street-Reconstruction>. I will send emails to remind you when the web page has been updated as well as specific project related info directly impacting your services and access.

Attached please find the project informational brochure. Please be aware of the traffic changes for the project. Prairie Street traffic between Wilson and Pine Street will be southbound only for the duration of the work and northbound traffic will be detoured to Raddant Road. Please refer to the map on the reverse side of this letter.

For those residents with driveway access on S Prairie Street your access will be affected while work is being performed at your driveway. Your driveway apron (the area within the right-of-way) will be replaced at no cost to you. You will be informed in advance of the necessary closures and provided on-street overnight parking passes. Please have vehicles out of your driveway and on a side street by 7:00AM of the day that work is scheduled to begin.

The City appreciates your continued cooperation and patience during this project. We look forward to a successful project for the City of Batavia. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me or any one of the contacts provided in the attached brochure. Thank you.

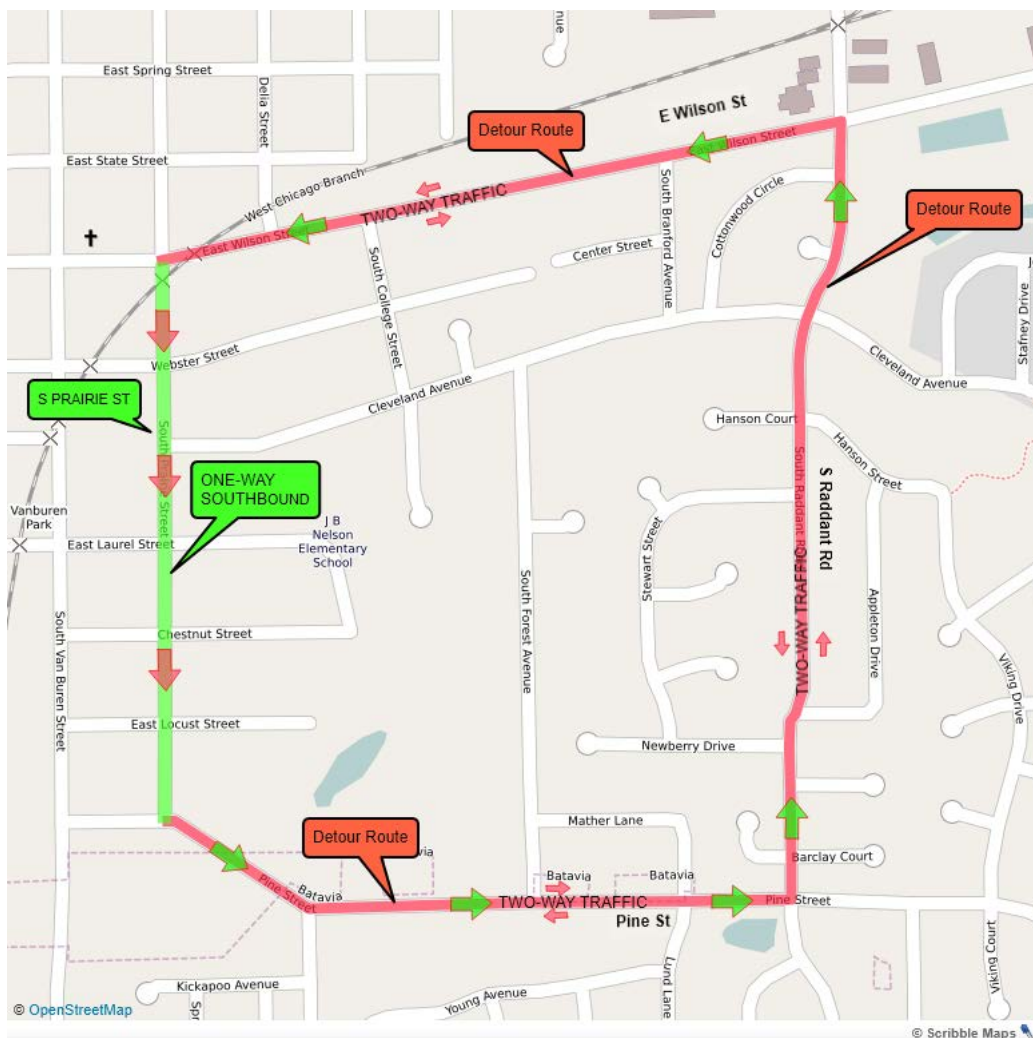
