Traffic Crash
Batavia Police Report # 21-1901

On Thursday, February 25, 2021 at approximately 11:41 AM, Batavia Police were dispatched to the area of West Fabyan Parkway and Carriage Drive for a traffic crash involving a gray Chevy Cruze and a maroon Dodge Caravan. As a result of the crash, the gray Chevy Cruze left the roadway and crashed through a nearby resident's fence. The vehicle came to rest in the resident's backyard and did not cause any damage to the residential structure. The driver of that vehicle was transported by paramedics to an area hospital for treatment. Preliminary investigation indicated that both vehicles were traveling westbound on Fabyan Parkway when the Chevy Cruze rear-ended the Dodge Caravan. The cause of the crash remains under investigation and no citations have been issued at this time.

The vehicles have been removed from the scene of the crash and the roadway has been reopened to normal traffic.
